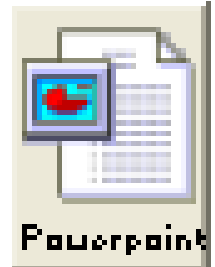


PowerPoint Button

The **PowerPoint** feature allows you to import a file that was created using Microsoft PowerPoint. However, the PowerPoint file must be saved as a .pps file. This can be done through the PowerPoint program.



Preliminary Setup

- ☞ First you will need to install the PowerPoint Viewer for '97. This is the only viewer that is currently compatible with the DSI Software. You may want to install the '97 Viewer Update as well. You can get both these files from the program CD, or download them from our website: <http://www.displaysystemsintl.com>
- ☞ Make sure that you have setup the PowerPoint show correctly, and that all slides will advance on their own, without a user to advance them manually.
- ☞ Save your PowerPoint show as a .pps file to your local hard drive. This is an option under 'Files of Type'.

Inserting the PowerPoint into the DSI

- ☞ In the Schedule Pages section, load your existing schedule, or create a new schedule.
- ☞ On the top toolbar, scroll to the right and click on the PowerPoint button. This will bring up an open window. Browse for the .pps file that you saved to your local hard drive, and click on Open.
- ☞ Your PowerPoint file will be inserted into your schedule. Save your Schedule and click on the Main Menu button on the top toolbar.
- ☞ At the Main Menu, click on Display Pages and select your schedule file. You will now see your schedule play, including your PowerPoint file.

Consider This...

- ☞ The DSI Software is only compatible with the PowerPoint '97 Viewer. If you create a PowerPoint show in a newer version, the PowerPoint show may not show up properly, or at all. This can also cause software instability. Please try to use PowerPoint '97 when creating shows for use with the DSI ELITEGOLD Software.
