

Using Windows XP and Service Pack 2
(for use with the TextPro Sr., ELITE2000 and ELITEGOLD)

With Service Pack 2 for Windows XP, there is a built in firewall which, by default, blocks all outgoing ports and connections. The following steps will explain how to configure the firewall so that you can still communicate between your DSI computers.

- ✍ After you install Service Pack 2 and run the DSI remote software, you may get a screen similar to the one displayed here. If you do, just ***click the Unblock*** button. This will now allow the DSI software to function as it originally did. If you don't get this message, and still can not communicate, please follow the next steps.



Manually Modify your Firewall

- ✍ From the Desktop of Windows, click on the Start button, Settings, and Control Panel. Then Click on Security Center. Once the Security Center is open, scroll to the bottom of the screen to the section called *Manage Security Settings for:* and click on the Windows Firewall. You will get a window such as the one displayed here.
- ✍ Click on the Exceptions Tab.
- ✍ Click on the Add Program button.
- ✍ Scroll through the list and select DSI Software and click OK.
- ✍ You will now have DSI Software in the list with a check mark beside it. Click on OK and close the Security Center.
- ✍ Run the DSI Software normally.
